- The local fire department having jurisdiction over the location where the substance release occurred senior fire officer on-scene will assign Incident Command (IC) to their senior fire officer on-scene.
- The IC will assess the substance release situation and determine the following:
 - 1. Substance identification
 - 2. Quantity of substance released
 - 3. Level of response
 - 4. Air, ground and water contamination concerns
 - 5. Evacuation concerns
 - 6. Alerting and notification methods
 - 7. Mutual aid requirements (if known).
- The IC will convey his assessment to the Communications Center (911) and/or EOC as soon as practical.
- Request Hazardous Materials Team thru Emergency Management Director. (EM director has authorized the City Fire Department Shift Commanders to deploy/ activate the county Hazardous Materials team in case the director is unavailable or cannot be reached.)
- Coordinate with the County Haz Mat team and provide support:
 - Perform emergency rescue.
 - Provide medical treatment as necessary.
 - Fight fires.
 - Ensure safety of responders.
 - Provide decon
- If level of training is appropriate, provide decontamination procedures.
